

BABY BUBBLES ON A CLOUD

Chain is worked in multiples of 3 + 2
(My version measures about 36" x 36")

Materials needed:

Approximately 14 ounces of any 100% acrylic worsted weight yarn and 7 ounces of another 100% acrylic worsted weight yarn. You can use ANY yarn you would like, but since this is for a baby, please use the softest possible.

J Hook (or any hook size you want – adjust quantity of yarn as necessary.)

Baby Bubble stitch is SC and 2 DC in the same stitch. ☺

Directions:

Chain 186 (36 inches wide)

Color A:

Row 1: In the second chain from hook SC and 2 DC (all three in same stitch). *Skip two chains and continue SC & 2 DC in third stitch (this creates the pattern stitch)* across. When you reach the end of the row, skip two chains and just SC in last stitch, ch 2 and turn.

Row 2: 2 DC in the SC (first stitch). *Skip two chains and continue SC & 2 DC in third stitch (this creates the pattern stitch)* When you get to the end of the row, skip those two chains and end the row with one SC, then CH 2 and turn.

REPEAT Row 2 until you reach 9 inches (each row is 1 inch and there are 9 rows)

Change to **Color B:**

Row 1-18: After you ended the previous row with CH 2 and turn, insert hook in second chain from hook and HDC across until you reach the end. CH 1 and turn.

Change to **Color A:**

*Repeat instructions for Rows 1 and 2 as above.

EDGING:

Row 1: SC around blanket with Color A. Make sure not to skip any stitches or you will make the blanket gather.

Row 2: Baby Bubble stitch as described above. OR use any edging you would like.
